## Re: Notice in accordance with Regulation 12 of the European Union (Waste Water Discharge) Regulations 2007 to 2020

January 14, 2022

Dear Sir or Madam

I refer to your application for a review of the waste water discharge licence relating to agglomeration named Ballyvourney Ballymakeery, Reg. No. D0299-02.

I am to advise you of a failure of compliance with:

Regulation 11 of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007, as amended. The notice as erected or fixed at the site contravenes Regulation 11

 (a) of the regulations. On inspection, the notice does not comply with the requirements specified in Regulation 10 (f) of the regulations. The notice did not specify the reference number given to the relevant licence in the register.

The Agency, therefore, requires you, in accordance with Regulation 12 of the regulations, to erect a further site notice that complies with the requirements of Regulation 11. The notice shall be maintained in the position where erected or fixed for a period of at least 5 weeks from the date of this notice.

You are required to provide evidence of the erected site notice containing the correct reference number given to the licence in the register. The evidence requested should be submitted by 18<sup>th</sup> February 2022.
