Application to the Environmental Protection Agency for the Review of a Waste Water Discharge Licence

Pursuant to Regulation 9 of the European Union (Waste Water Discharge) Regulations 2007 to 2020, Irish Water, Colvill House, 24-26 Talbot Street, Dublin 1, intend to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency for the review of the Waste Water Discharge Licence (D0299-01) for the Ballyvourney/Ballymakeera Waste Water Works, Co. Cork. The waste water works consists of a new waste water treatment plant at Shanacloon Townland, 121316E, 076048N; a new Primary Discharge (SW001) and new Storm Water Overflow (SW002) from the WWTP, which discharge into the Sullane River, an upgraded Pumping Station at Ballymakeery Townland, 121295E, 076419N, a Storm Water Overflow (SW003) and Emergency Overflow (SW004) from the Pumping Station which discharge into the Sullane River.
