Notice in accordance with Regulation 7 of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013 as amended, in respect of a licence review from ERAS ECO Limited for an installation located at Foxhole, Youghal, County Cork, P36 F903

Dear Mr O'Callaghan,

Further to our telephone conversation of 28 January 2022.

I refer to your application for a licence review received by the EPA on 18 January 2022 and am to advise that in accordance with Regulation 7 of the EPA (IE) (Licensing) Regulations 2013 as amended, the information required under the regulations in support of the application must be updated to reflect compliance with Regulation 7(b) as follows:

1. A period of more than two weeks has elapsed between the publication of the newspaper notice required under the regulations and the submission of this application.
2. The extract of the site notice was not included in the application submitted under evidence of notices.

The EPA therefore requires you to republish the newspaper and the site notice referring to the '[Newspaper Notice - Guidance for Applicants](#)' and '[Site Notice - Guidance for Applicants](#)' documents on the EPA website.

Please submit the following evidence that you have complied with the regulations:

1. An extract of the revised notice published in the newspaper, in PDF format;
2. An extract of the revised site notice erected on site;
3. Photographic evidence of the revised site notice erected on site.

The requested information should be submitted to the EPA within 28 Calendar Days of the date of this notice in order to allow the EPA to process and determine your application.

It should be noted that the eight-week period within which the EPA is to decide the proposed determination will commence on the day on which this notice has been complied with.
