PUBLIC NOTICE

APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE REVIEW OF THE WHITEGATE-AGHADA AGGLOMERATION WASTE WATER DISCHARGE LICENCE.

Pursuant to Regulation 5 of the European Union (Waste Water Discharge) Regulations 2007 to 2008, Irish Water, Civil House, 24-26 Talbot Street, Dublin 1, intend to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency for the review of the Whitegate-Aghada Waste Water Discharge Licence (00423-01). The waste water works will consist of a new primary wastewater treatment plant at Sallygeen, 283256E, 62435N, a new primary discharge point discharging to Outer Cork Harbour, 3 dual function storm water/ emergency overflows and associated sewer network and pumping stations.
