**Re: Notice in accordance with Regulation 18(6)(b) of the European Union (Waste Water Discharge) Regulations 2007 to 2020**

Dear Sir or Madam

I refer to your application for a waste water discharge licence relating to agglomeration named Ballyvourney Ballymakeery, Reg. No. D0299-02.

In accordance with Regulation 18(6)(b) of the European Union (Waste Water Discharge) Regulations 2007 to 2020, I have concluded, based on preliminary examination, that there is significant and realistic doubt in regard to the likelihood of significant effects on the environment arising from the proposed development.

You are therefore required to submit the information specified in Schedule 7A of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001, as amended, for the purposes of a screening determination. In accordance with Regulation 18(7), the Schedule 7A information:

- a) shall be accompanied by any further relevant information on the characteristics of the proposed development and its likely significant effects on the environment including, where relevant, information on how the available results of other relevant assessments of the effects on the environment carried out pursuant to European Union legislation other than the Environmental Impact Assessment Directive have been taken into account; and
- b) may be accompanied by a description of the features, if any, of the proposed development and the measures, if any, envisaged to avoid or prevent what might otherwise have been significant adverse effects on the environment of the development.

Your reply to this notice should include a revised non-technical summary which reflects the information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary of the application.

Please provide the information by 30<sup>th</sup> March 2022.
