## **GOOD HOUSE KEEPING**

The following measures are adhered to as part of the BAT 'Good Housekeeping Requirements' as listed hereunder

- 1. Proper location of the plant/farm and spatial arrangements of the activities in order to:
  - Transport of animals and materials (including manure) is reduced by having under-slat slurry storage and housing all animals on the one site;
  - The construction of under-ground slurry stores reduces risks of contaminating surface waters. Construction of leak-detection facilities reduces risks to ground waters.
- 2. Education and train staff, in relation to
  - Relevant regulations, livestock farming, animal health and welfare, manure management, worker safety;
  - Manure transport and land-spreading controls and adherence to SI 605 of 2017 (as amended);
  - Planning of activities in advance to allow proper execution of work processes;
  - · Emergency planning and management; and
  - Repair and maintenance of equipment.
- 3. Preparation of an emergency plan for dealing with unexpected emissions and incidents such as pollution of water bodies.
  - Providing a list of emergency numbers to contact in case of emergencies;
  - Provision of record sheets to be completed in the case of emergencies / incidents / complaints;
  - Provision of a plan of the farm showing the drainage systems and water/effluent sources:
    - Provision of plans of action for responding to certain potential events (e.g. fires, leaking or collapsing of slurry stores, uncontrolled run-off from manure heaps, oil spillages);
  - Provision of available equipment for dealing with a pollution incident (e.g. equipment for plugging land drains, damming ditches, scum boards for oil spillages).
- 4. Regularly checking, repairing and maintaining structures and equipment, such as
  - Slurry stores for any sign of damage, degradation, leakage;
  - Slurry pumps, agitators;
  - Water supply and feed systems;
  - Ventilation and temperature sensors
  - Silos and transport equipment (e.g. valves, tubes etc); General cleanliness and pest control measures.
