Pursuant to Regulation 9 of the European Union (Waste Water Discharge) Regulations 2007 to 2020, Irish Water, Colvill House, 24-26 Talbot Street, Dublin 1, intend to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency for the review of the Waste Water Discharge Licence (D0057-01) for the Crosshaven, Carrigaline, Ringaskiddy Agglomeration. The waste water works consists of a new waste water treatment plant at Shanbally, Co. Cork, an existing primary discharge (SW001), which discharges into the Cork Harbour; Network and Dual function storm water overflows (i.e. act as a storm water or emergency overflow depending on the event), and associated sewer network and pump stations.

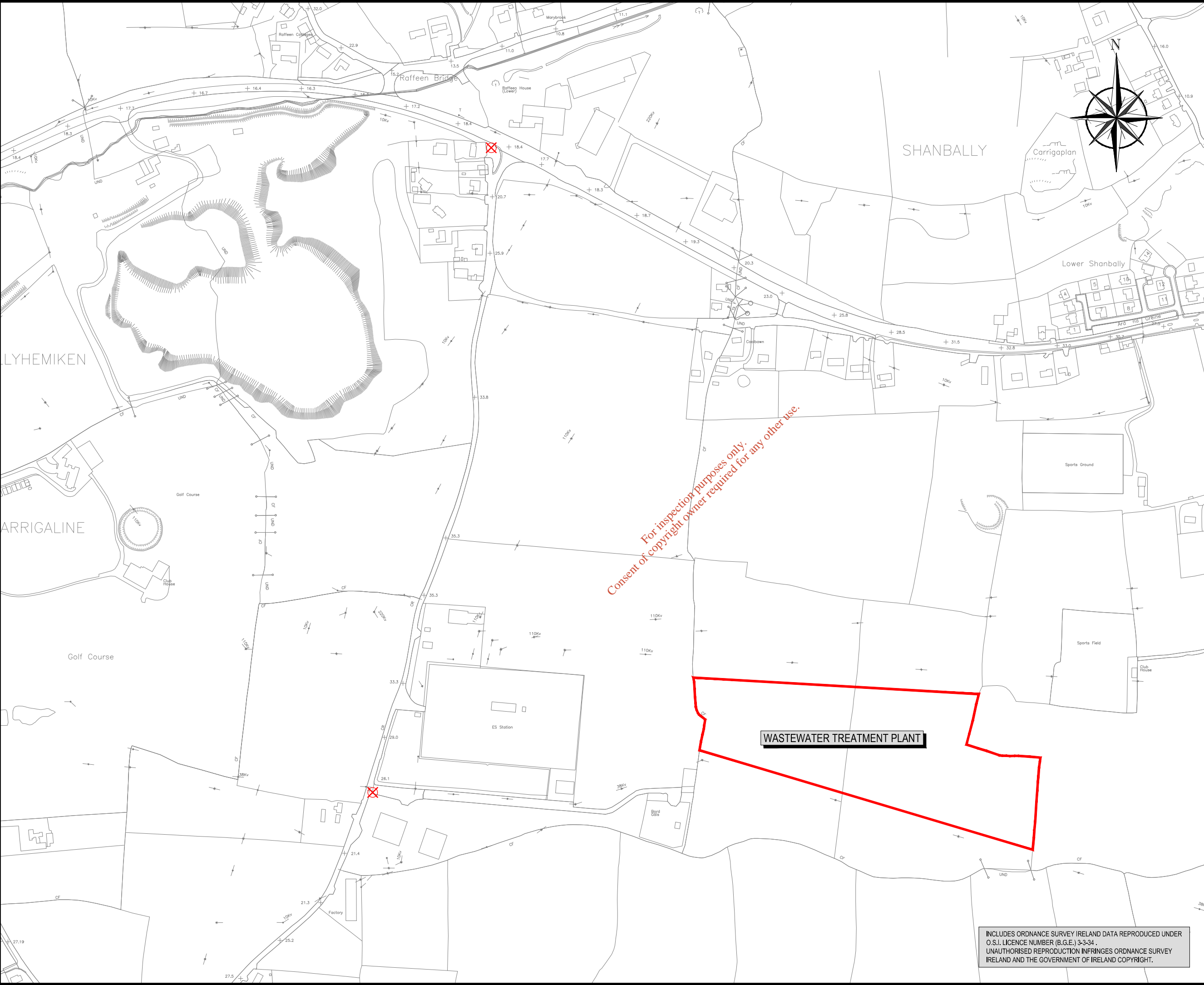
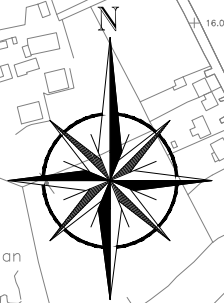
