AA Screening Determination:

That the activity is not directly connected with or necessary to the management of any European site and that it cannot be excluded, on the basis of objective information, that the activity, individually or in combination with other plans or projects, will have a significant effect on any European site and accordingly determined that an Appropriate Assessment of the activity is required. The reasons for this determination is as follows:

- There is a hydrological connection between the closed landfill and the Lough Ree SAC (site code: 000440) and Lough Ree SPA (site code: 004064), via the system of land drains which discharge into an unnamed river (IE_SH_26I011350; segment code: 26_4112) which in turn discharges into the Inny river (waterbody code: IE_SH_26I011350, waterbody code: 26_959). The Inny river forms part of the Lough Ree SAC (site code: 000440) and Lough Ree SPA (site code: 004064).
- There is no hydrological connection between the site and the following European Sites: Mount Jessop Bog SAC (Site Code: 002202), Glen Lough SPA (Site Code: 004045) and Ballymore Fen SAC (Site Code: 002313).
