

## **Notice for Public Consultation on Appropriate Assessment**

## under Regulation 42 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 as amended

The EPA on 20 November 2018 issued an Appropriate Assessment Screening Determination to William Connolly & Sons Unlimited Company for an installation located at Grange Lower, Goresbridge, Kilkenny, R95 EKH4 regarding an Industrial Emissions licence application, Register Number P1069-01.

The application is for the operation of an existing feed mill with a current capacity to process up to 200,000 tonnes per annum of animal feed. Animal Feed is manufactured at the installation predominantly for the equine industry with varying amounts for cattle and sheep. The installation will include grain, seed and raw material storage sheds and associated dryers; feed manufacturing buildings; vehicle maintenance garage and refuelling area; product distribution areas and vehicle parking; and an integrated constructed wetland (ICW) for the management of stormwater from the installation.

The EPA has carried out an Appropriate Assessment Screening and has determined that an Appropriate Assessment <u>is required</u> for the activity. The applicant has submitted a Natura Impact Statement.

Information on making submissions or observations and on the public participation process is available on the Agency's website.

The EPA shall publish its proposed determination (grant/refusal) on its website, and before making a final determination, the EPA shall consider any objections / submissions on objections. The final determination will also be published on the website.
