Regulation 10(2)(b)(ii) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, in respect of a licence review from Starrus Eco Holdings Limited for an installation located at Cappagh Road, Finglas, Dublin 11

Dear Sir/Madam,

I refer to the application for a licence received by the EPA on 09 November 2021.

Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with the above-mentioned legislation. You are therefore requested, in accordance with the regulations, to supply the information detailed below.

It is noted that an application for planning permission is under consideration at this time.

- (i) In accordance with section 87(1B)(b) of the Act of 1992 provide, a copy of the final grant of planning permission together with either:
 - a. a copy of the environmental impact assessment (EIA) report (if not already submitted), and any updates relating to EIA required during the application for planning permission process, or
 - b. a written confirmation from the planning authority or An Bord Pleanála that an environmental impact assessment was not required by or under the Act of 2000 (if not already submitted).

The requested information should be submitted to the Agency within *4 weeks from date of final grant of permission*, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application.

It should be noted that the eight-week period within which the Agency is to decide the proposed determination will commence on the day on which this notice has been complied with. If you have any further queries please contact licensing@epa.ie.
