## Re: Notice in accordance with Regulation 12 of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007 to 2020

April 28, 2022

Dear Sir or Madam

I refer to your application for a waste water discharge licence relating to agglomeration named Ringaskiddy, Reg. No. D0057-02.

I am to advise you of a failure of compliance with:

 Regulation 11 of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007, as amended. The notice as erected or fixed at the site contravenes Regulation 11(d) of the regulations. On inspection, the notice as erected was not maintained in the position where erected or fixed for a period of at least 5 weeks after the making of the relevant application.

The Agency, therefore, requires you, in accordance with Regulation 12 of the regulations, to erect a further site notice that complies with the requirements of Regulation 11. The notice shall be maintained in the position where erected or fixed for a period of at least 5 weeks from the date of this notice.

You are required to provide evidence of the erected site notice containing the correct reference number given to the licence in the register. The evidence requested should be submitted by 2 June 2022.
