Dear Inspector,

Re: Bandon Waste Water Discharge Authorisation Application D0136

Further to Regulation 14(5) notice dated 10 November 2021, and 3rd June 2022 requesting IW to submit a license review application by 10/05/2022.

The Agency has requested Irish Water to submit a completed application form and the relevant supporting documentation including the appropriate fee.

The licence review application is for the existing Mallow wastewater treatment plant and will take into account the operational discharges from the collection network after the completion of the Sewerage Scheme Upgrade Project.

As the licence review application is associated with a wastewater treatment plant with a capacity of greater than 10,000 p.e, our understanding is that a mandatory Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) is required for this particular Project, as per Regulation 17 of the relevant Waste Water Discharge Regulations, 2007- 2020.

Irish Water is currently preparing the relevant technical supporting reports to accompany the licence review application including the EIAR.

Irish Water proposes to submit the completed application and supporting technical documentation by end of November 2022.
