I refer to the related EPA correspondence dated 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022 which requested confirmation whether the operational period for the landfill is as stated in the Application Form.

Galway County Council has concluded the related investigations, including the retrieval of information contained in archived files. The information retrieved indicates that the Tuam landfill accepted 11,000 tonnes of waste per annum and closed on 30th September 1998 as prescribed in S.I. No. 133/1997 - Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 1997, First Schedule, 'Prescribed dates for the purpose of Section 39(1) of the Waste Management Act 1996'.
