Regulation 10(2)(b)(ii) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, in respect of a licence review from Woodville Pig Farms Limited for an installation located at Woodville and Ballyknockane, Ballymackey, Nenagh, County Tipperary.

Dear Mr. O'Looney,

I refer to the application for a licence received by the EPA on 26 May 2020. Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with the above-mentioned legislation. You are therefore requested, in accordance with the regulations, to supply the information detailed below.

- 1. Submit an additional site plan showing the Ballyknockane finishing unit. Include the full site boundary outlined in red and all relevant infrastructure, such as the stormwater drainage system, stormwater discharge points, leak detection monitoring points, and groundwater wells.
- 2. Submit a grid reference for stormwater discharge point SW-1.
- 3. With respect to the proposal to utilise a feed silo as an emissions stack:
 - a. Provide a plan and elevation drawing of the proposed stack, and include the location of fans within the stack where applicable; and
 - b. Update the site plan to indicate the location of the stack, ensuring that the stack is within the red line boundary of the licenced site.

In addition to the above, please also provide an updated non-technical summary (Application Form, and EIS where applicable) to reflect the information provided in your reply, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.

The requested information should be submitted to the Agency within **two weeks** of the date of this notice, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application.

It should be noted that the eight-week period within which the Agency is to decide the proposed determination will commence on the day on which this notice has been complied with. If you have any further queries please contact <u>licensing@epa.ie</u>.

In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.
