

## EIA Screening Determination

### EIA Screening Determination:

EIA, as respects the matters that come within the functions of the Agency, is required for the activity to which the above licence application relates due to the following reasons:

The activity exceeds the following threshold in Part 2 of Schedule 5 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 as amended:

*1.(e)(i) Installations for intensive rearing of poultry not included in Part 1 of this Schedule which would have more than 40,000 places for poultry.*
