To Whom it may concern,

Condition 7.25 of the licence states as follows:

"Notwithstanding the requirements of Condition 1.2 of this IPC licence and prior to the provision of alternative arrangements to treat gases from the processes (refer Condition 5.18), the maximum quantity of animal by-products and/or SRM to be accepted at the site of the activity for processing shall not exceed 375 tonnes on any one day. Following commissioning of the new gas treatment system, a revised maximum quantity of animal by-products and/or SRM to be accepted at the site, is to be

submitted to the Agency for approval, in accordance with the provisions of Condition 1.2 of this licence"

In January 2007, following commissioning of the above referenced gas treatment system, the Agency, in accordance with condition 7.25 of the license, approved the revised maximum quantity to be

accepted at the site to 450 tonnes per day with a maximum weekly tonnage of 2,625 tonnes.

The Company wish to rectify the error in the Emissions Impact Assessment submitted to the Agency on 22nd September 2021. The submission should have stated that the maximum tonnage to be accepted to site under the terms of the existing licence is 450 tonnes (not 375 tonnes) per day and the maximum

weekly tonnage shall not exceed 2625 tonnes.
