I refer to your email correspondence, dated 26<sup>th</sup> August 2022, and acknowledge the change of contact for Clare County Council in relation to historic landfills.

Please be advised that the Agency cannot facilitate your request for an extension of time for a representation on the draft certificate of authorisation issued on 20<sup>th</sup> July 2022 for Kilrush Landfill (Reg. No. H0030-01). As per Regulation 7(5), of the Waste Management (Certificate of Historic Unlicensed Waste Disposal and Recovery Activity) Regulations 2008, only representations received by the Agency within a period of 30 days from the issuing of the draft certificate of authorisation shall be considered. It is therefore not possible to consider any representation received after this date.

Regarding your request for an extension of time in which to respond to the Agency's notice of 9<sup>th</sup> August 2022, regarding the application for a certificate of authorisation for Whitegate Landfill (Reg. No. H0035-01), please be advised that this request can be accommodated. Accordingly, please respond to the said notice no later than **three weeks** from the date of this letter.
