Dear Mr Durkan

I refer to your letter dated 23/03/06 received by the Agency on 24/03/06 in relation to your request to accept onto site up to 600 tonnes per day of animal by-products.

AIBP DEVELOPMENT

Condition 7.25 of IPC Licence Reg. No. P0040-02 allows the licensee to accept 375 tonnes per day, which amounts to 2625 tonnes for a seven-day week.

I am to advise you that the Agency agrees to revise the maximum daily quantity of animal by-products to 450 tonnes per day under Condition 7.25 of IPC Licence Reg. No. P0040-02, subject to the following:

- The maximum weekly tonnage shall not exceed 2625 tonnes;
- The increase in the limit of the daily tonnage to be accepted onsite is on a trial basis for six months from the date of this correspondence, after which time the situation will be reviewed;
- The increase in tonnage accepted is subject to the processing and abatement systems having the capacity to treat the accepted material.
- The licensee must comply with Condition 5.16, and ensure that all operations onsite shall be carried out in a manner such that air emissions and/or odours do not
 result in significant impairment of, os significant interference with amenities or
 the environment beyond the site boundary and at odour sensitive locations.

The Agency reminds the licensee that emissions must conform to the emission limit values set out in Integrated Pollution Control Licence (Reg. No. P0040-02), and the licensee is required to comply with all conditions of the licence.
