Clerical Amendment to Industrial Emissions Licence, Register

Number P0986-01, held by Timoleague Agri Gen Limited,

Barryshall, Timogleague, Bandon, County Cork.

1. Recommendation

I recommend that the licence amendment be approved as set out in the attached recommended Clerical Amendment A.

2. Background

RE:

Timoleague Agri Gen Limited was granted an Industrial Emission Licence; Reg. No. P0986-01 on 15 November 2016 for a facility located at Barryshall, Timoleague, Bandon, County Cork.

A clerical amendment is required to correct a clerical error noted in the Licence, Reg. No. P0986-01 issued on 15 November 2016 to allow for the correct interpretation of the Licence requirements.

3. Assessment

On 20 July 2022, the Agency initiated a Clerical Amendment of Industrial Emissions Licence Reg. No. P0986-01, in order to allow for:

The Amendment of *Schedule C.3.4 Monitoring of Storm Water Emissions* to include the monitoring of Total Organic Carbon(TOC) in Stormwater discharges.

Condition 6.15.2 of the licence requires that "The licensee shall within six months of commencement of the activity, establish suitable trigger levels for TOC, total ammonia and suspended solids in storm water discharges, such that storm waters exceeding these levels will be diverted for retention and suitable disposal".

Condition 6.2 of the licence requires that monitoring to be undertaken in accordance with the requirements of Schedule C of the licence. *Schedule C.3.4 Monitoring of Storm Water Emissions* requires a list of parameters to be monitored but it does not make reference to Total Organic Carbon(TOC).

OEE require *Schedule C.3.4 Monitoring of Storm Water Emissions* to be amended so that Total Organic Carbon(TOC) is monitored and they can thus assess against the requirements of Condition 6.15.2 of the EPA licence.

This memo recommends that the change may be accommodated by a Clerical Amendment, in accordance with Section 96(1)(a) of the EPA Act 1992 as amended.
