AA Screening Determination:

That the activity is not directly connected with or necessary to the management of any European site and that it can be excluded, on the basis of objective information, that the activity, individually or in combination with other plans or projects, will have a significant effect on any European site and accordingly determined that an Appropriate Assessment of

the activity was not required.

This determination has been made in light of the following reasons:

- The installation is located in a business park and is not within a European Site.
- European Sites and their qualifying interests are considered to be outside of the zone of influence of air and noise emissions arising at the installation with the closest European Site being approximately 5kms away (Rye Water Valley/Carton SAC). Emissions to air consist of emissions from the diesel-powered back-up generators and diesel-powered fire sprinkler pump.
- There are no process emissions to sewer.
- There are no direct process emissions to surface water, ground or groundwater from the installation.
- Given the nature and scale of emissions, it is considered that the activity in combination with other plans or projects will not have a significant effect on European Sites.
