1.0 INTRODUCTION:

This document sets out the response to Item 7 of the additional information request under Regulation 10(2)(b)(ii) received 27th October 2022 in respect of the Industrial Emissions licence application from Amazon Data Services Ireland Limited for an installation located at Amazon Data Services Ireland Limited, Grange Castle South Business Park, Baldonnel Road, Dublin 22, D22 E7C9. Item 7 requested that the Applicant supply the follwing information:

The Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) relating to this activity, prepared by Marston Planning Consultancy et. al. dated April 2020, which has been previously submitted to SDCC for Planning Ref. SD20A/0121 has been submitted to the Agency as part of this application (Attachment 6-3-6 of the IE Licence application).

2.0 **RESPONSE**

The preparation and co-ordination of the EIAR was undertaken by competent and experienced subject matter experts. Each environmental specialist of the applicants project team was commissioned having regard to their previous experience in EIA; their knowledge of relevant environmental legislation relevant to their topic; familiarity with the relevant standards and criteria for evaluation relevant to their topic; ability to interpret the specialised documentation of the construction sector and to understand and anticipate how their topic will be affected during construction and operation phases of development; ability to arrive at practicable and reliable measure to mitigate or avoid adverse environmental impacts; and to clearly and comprehensively present their findings.
