3. Objection to a Proposed Determination of an Application for a Waste Licence

The Directors considered the following documentation: Proposed Decision issued on 13 June 2022; one First-Party objection; and the Report and Recommendations of the Technical Committee, Office of Environmental Sustainability, dated 3 November 2022.

Technical Committee Report

The Directors noted the Technical Committee Report. The Directors approved the recommendations of the Technical Committee with the following amendment:

B.2 Schedule B: Emission Limits B.2 Emissions to Water

Amend the new Condition 3.24 as follows:

‘3.24 Within six months of date of grant of the licence, the licensee shall install a storm water retention pond, fitted with a flow restrictor at the outlet. The flow of storm water from the storm water retention pond to the River Ward shall be ~~limited~~ *restricted* during periods of low river flow.’

Reason for decision:

In the interest of providing clarity.

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to GLV Bay Lane Limited for their facility at Bay Lane Quarry, Bay Lane, St. Margaret's, County Dublin, Register of Licence W0301-01, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
