APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE REVIEW OF A WASTE WATER DISCHARGE LICENCE

Pursuant to Regulation 9 of the European Union (Waste Water Discharge) Regulations 2007 to 2020, Irish Water, Colvill House, 24-26 Talbot Street, Dublin 1, intend to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency for the Review of the Waste Water Discharge Licence (D0437-01) for Boherbue Wastewater Agglomeration, Co Cork. The works consists of an upgrade to the existing WwTP in the townland of Laharan at Boherbue, which will comprise new inlet works, new storm water overflow, new aeration tanks, new settlement tanks, new cloth filter, new storm water holding tank and associated storm water overflow, new sludge drying reed beds and new treated effluent pipeline to the existing primary discharge point located within the site boundary, as well as decommissioning of the existing wastewater treatment plant and associated structures. Details of the location of these works and associated discharges are as follows:




