Dear Sir,

I refer to the application for a licence received by the EPA on 21 January 2022.

Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with the above mentioned legislation. You are therefore requested, in accordance with the regulations, to supply the information detailed below.

EIA

- With regards to the Environmental Impact Assessment Report documentation (EIAR) submitted with the licence applications, it is noted that a number of Environmental Impact Assessment Reports (EIAR) and an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) have been submitted. It is noted that a number of sections have been omitted from the documents.
 - a) Provide the non-technical summary (NTS) of each of the EIARs:
 - I. the EIAR (and addendum EIAR) associated with planning permission 3803/20;
 - II. the EIAR associated with planning permission 4185/18; and
 - III. the EIAR associated with planning permission 3096/18 (Regulation 9(2)(e)).
- 2. Provide Appendix 11.1 Photomontages (amended) of the addendum EIAR associated with planning permission 3803/20 (Regulation 9(2)(e)).

3. Final grants of planning permission have been included in the licence application for a number of the relevant planning permissions for the activity. However, with regards to

planning permission ref. no. 3634/15, you are required to submit a copy of Dublin City

Council's final grant of planning permission (Regulation 9(2)(e)).

In addition to the above, please also provide an updated non-technical summary

(Application Form, and EIAR where applicable) to reflect the information provided in your

reply, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.

The requested information should be submitted to the Agency within <u>two weeks</u> of the date

of this notice, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application.

It should be noted that the eight-week period within which the Agency is to decide the

proposed determination will commence on the day on which this notice has been complied

this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to

annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are

correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.
