



Notice for Public Consultation on Appropriate Assessment

under Regulation 42 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 as amended

The EPA has given notice of its Appropriate Assessment Screening Determination to Uisce Éireann relating to an application for a review of Waste Water Discharge Licence for the Ballycotton agglomeration, Co. Cork, Register Number D0516-02.

This application is for the authorisation of waste water discharges from the waste water works serving the agglomeration. The application relates to waste water works, which includes a proposed waste water treatment plant providing preliminary and primary treatment. The waste water discharges from the waste water works are to Ballycotton Bay (WFD Code: IE_SW_040_0000). The population equivalent (p.e) to which the application relates is 1,082 p.e.

The EPA has carried out an Appropriate Assessment Screening and has determined that an Appropriate Assessment is required for the activity. The licensee will be requested to submit a Natura Impact Statement.
