Further Notice under the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, in respect of a licence application from M.A.G. World Limited for an installation located at Lisgar and Corglass, Bailieboro, County Cavan.

Dear Mr. Fay,

I refer to the EPA's notice of 13 January 2023 requesting information in respect of your licence application. You are advised that there remains outstanding information, as required under the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, as amended. You are therefore required to submit the outstanding information detailed below:

1. Storm water

Your response of 23 January 2023, in relation to storm water, is incomplete and contains information which conflicts with the original application.

Attachment 7.7 of the application (Discharges to Storm Water) lists three storm water discharge points (SW 1, SW 2 and SW 3) whereas the updated site plan outlines seven storm water discharge points (SW 1, SW 2, SW 3, SW 4, SW 5, SW 6 and SW 7).

- a) Provide the following outstanding information:
 - i. An updated version of Attachment 7.7 which includes the additional discharge points outlined on the site plan received 23 January 2023; and
 - ii. Ensure that <u>all</u> sections are complete including <u>a description of the discharge points</u>, <u>controls and receiving bodies</u>, <u>and the grid references for existing monitoring points</u>.
- b) In addition, ensure the following information is provided in full:
 - Clarification on which discharge points are existing <u>and</u> the corresponding grid references;
 - ii. The existing and proposed pathways between <u>each</u> storm water discharge point and the receiving waterbody; and

- iii. Further details of any existing and proposed storm water discharges to ground including the discharge point(s), the pathway(s) and the soakpit(s).
- c) Update the site plan to:
 - Include further flow directional arrows to fully outline the existing and proposed storm water pathways on-site; and
 - ii. Outline fully any existing and proposed discharges to ground including the discharge point(s), the pathways(s) on-site and soakpit(s).
- d) There is a soakpit identified on the site plan (north-west side of proposed House No. 2). Clarify:
 - Whether this soakpit is existing or proposed;
 - ii. What material currently discharges and/or will discharge to this soakpit; and
 - iii. As per point 1(c)ii above, update the flow directional arrows on the site plan accordingly.

2. Water supply

Your response of 23 January 2023, in relation to water supply, is incomplete and contains information which conflicts with the original application.

The original application detailed usage of 5,000m³ water per annum. Your response of 23 January 2023 refers to usage of 3,250m³ water per annum from the Drumkerry Group Water Scheme. This response also refers to a back-up well on-site.

Provide clarification on the following:

- a) Has the estimated total water usage per annum for the proposed activity been revised to 3,250m³ or is it still 5,000m³ as outlined in the application? If the latter, clarify if any quantities above 3,250m³ will be supplied from the back-up well onsite;
- b) Clarify if the well is existing or proposed;
- c) If the well is existing, provide the corresponding grid reference; and
- d) Confirm if the group water scheme is the Drumkerry Group Water Scheme (as detailed in response from the applicant dated 23 January 2023) or the Drumkeery Group Water Scheme.

With a view to advancing this application for determination, the above-mentioned information should be submitted to the EPA within 2 weeks.
