

Notice for Public Consultation on Appropriate Assessment

under Regulation 42 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 as amended

The EPA has given notice of its Appropriate Assessment Screening Determination to Uisce Éireann relating to an application for a review of a Waste Water Discharge Licence for the Boherbue and Environs agglomeration, in the townlands of Boherbue and Laharn West, Co Cork, Register Number D0437-02.

This application is for the authorisation of waste water discharges from the waste water works serving the agglomeration. The application relates to waste water works, which includes proposed upgrades of the waste water treatment plant providing tertiary treatment including phosphorous removal and improvements to reduce ammonia. The waste water discharges from the waste water works are to the Brogeen River (IE_SW_18_B060300). The population equivalent (p.e) to which the application relates is 1,350 p.e.

The EPA has carried out an Appropriate Assessment Screening and has determined that an Appropriate Assessment <u>is required</u> for the waste water discharges. The licensee has submitted a Natura Impact Statement.
