<u>Re: Notice pursuant to Regulation 28 of the EPA (Industrial Emissions)(Licensing)</u> <u>Regulations 2013, in respect of the proposed determination on a licence review</u> <u>application by SSE Generation Ireland Limited, Reg. No. P0606-04.</u>

Dear Mr. Storey,

I refer to objections received in relation to the Agency's proposed determination on the above referenced licence review application. I am to advise that the Agency requests that you submit further information in relation to a matter which has arisen during the course of considering the objections.

In this context and in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 28 of the above referenced Regulations, you are requested to make a submission in relation to these matters:

- The input (MWth) and output (MWe) capacities of the installation referenced in the licence review application, differ from those referenced in the previous licence review application (P0606-03) and in planning permission (Ref. no. 26.PA0016), granted for the construction of the CCGT by An Bord Pleanála.
- 2. Having regard to sections 1, 3, and 4 of the objection by Mr. Paul Barlow received by the Agency on 07 March 2022, confirm that planning permission is in place for the installation, as constructed and operated, and has been agreed with the planning authority.

I am to request that you submit the specified information to the Agency no later **21 days** from the date of this notice. It should be noted <u>that if the above specified</u> <u>information is not received by this time, the Agency will,</u> after the expiration of the period, and without further notice, proceed with its consideration of the objection and make a final decision on the application.
