The Directors considered a recommendation from the Office of Environmental Sustainability that the Agency approve the Recommended Determination to grant a review of the Industrial Emissions Licence. The Directors approved the recommendation with the following amendments:

Glossary of Terms

Amend the term IBA to read as follows:

'Incinerator Bottom Ash (non-hazardous).'

Reason for Decision:

To provide clarity on the Glossary of Terms.

Conditions

3.34.3 Amend the condition as follows:

'The licensee shall, consult with Inland Fisheries Ireland prior to one

month prior to the commencement of works associated with the installation of the culvert at the northern surface water management system and the onsite realignment of the Knockharley Stream (Flemingstown River, IE_EA_08F050930), submit to the Agency a surface water works project plan which includes:

- (i) A copy of the relevant approvals from the Office of Public Works;
- (ii) Recommendations following consultation with Inland Fisheries Ireland; and
- (iii) An implementation plan to address (i) and (ii) above including timelines for works. No instream works shall be are to be carried out between 01 October and 30 June in any given year.'

Reason for Decision:

To provide clarity on the condition requirements.

3.36.2 Amend the condition as follows:

'Unless otherwise approved by the Agency, leachate from the following waste types shall be extracted, collected, stored, pretreated (if treatment implemented onsite pre-treatment approved to be implemented on site) and removed from site separately to facilitate leachate treatment and prevent dilution or cross contamination of streams:

- (i) SNRHW;
- (ii) IBA;
- (iii) Stabilised and inert waste; and
- (iv) Non-stabilised waste.'

Reason for Decision:

To provide clarity on the condition requirements.

6.16.3 Amend the condition as follows:

'Within 6 months of the date of grant of this licence, and biennially thereafter, the licensee shall review the technology related to electronic odour monitoring and trial or implement a suitable device as part of odour management controls, unless otherwise approved by the Agency.'

Reason for Decision:

To provide clarity on the condition requirements.

Schedule A: Limitations A.2 Waste Acceptance

Note 4 Amend note 4 to read as follows:

'A maximum of 5,000 tonnes per annum of baled recyclables & and baled municipal solid waste shall be accepted for storage, prior to onward recovery/disposal off-site. These wastes shall not be placed in the landfill void.'

Reason for Decision:

To provide clarity on the waste acceptance requirements.

Note 6 Amend note 6 to read as follows:

'Unless otherwise approved by the Agency, tThis is the maximum quantity of all waste to be accepted at the installation in a calendar year, including any reserved contingency capacity required in accordance with planning permission reference ABP-303211-18. Any waste material utilised for capping and profiling shall be counted within this total.'

Reason for Decision:

To provide clarity on the waste acceptance requirements.

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a review of the licence, to Knockharley Landfill Limited, Knockharley, Navan, (Includes Townlands of Tuiterath & Flemingstown), County Meath, Register of Licence No W0146-04, subject to amendments and the conditions as set out in the licence.
