## **Appropriate Assessment Screening Determination**

In accordance with Regulation 42(1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 as amended, the Agency has undertaken Appropriate Assessment screening to assess, in view of best scientific knowledge and the conservation objectives of the site, if the activity individually or in combination with other plans or projects is likely to have a significant effect on a European Site(s). In this context, particular attention was paid to the European Site(s) listed below.

## **AA Screening Determination:**

That the activity not directly connected with or necessary to the management of any European site and that it can be excluded, on the basis of objective information, that the activity individually or in combination with other plans or projects, will have a significant effect on any European site and accordingly determined that an Appropriate Assessment of the activity was not required.

This determination has been made in light of the following reasons:

- The installation is not located within any European site;
- Due to the nature of noise emissions from the activity and the distance to European Sites
  and their qualifying interest. The nearest European site with species that may be noise
  sensitive is the Lower River Suir SAC, which is > 6 km south east of the installation. Due to its
  distance, this European site is considered beyond the zone of influence of noise emissions
  from the installation;
- Due to the nature of fugitive dust and odour emissions from the activity, and the distance to European sites and their qualifying interest habitats and species. The nearest European site is the Lower River Suir SAC, which is > 6 km south east of the installation.
- There are no process emissions to surface water or groundwater from the installation.
- The only discharge to water from the installation will be stormwater runoff from building and non-process hardstanding areas. Stormwater is discharged, via an Integrated Constructed Wetland and 1 km surface water drain, to the Stillimity Stream which is a tributary of the Moyle River. The Moyle River flows into the Lower River Suir Estuary, which is approximately

15 km downstream of the installation. As there is only a storm water discharge from the installation and due to the separation distance, it is considered that significant effects on European sites and their water dependant qualifying interests (habitats and species) can be ruled out.

• Given the nature and scale of emissions, it is considered that the activity in combination with other plans or projects will not have a significant effect on European sites.
