AA Screening Determination:

That the activity is not directly connected with or necessary to the management of any European site and that it cannot be excluded, on the basis of objective information, that the activity, individually or in combination with other plans or projects, will have a significant effect on any European site and accordingly determined that an Appropriate Assessment of the activity is required. This determination has been made in light of the following reason:

• There is a hydrological connection between the closed landfill and the Clonakilty Bay SAC (site code: 000091) and the Clonkilty Bay SPA (site code: 004081) as the closed landfill is located directly adjacent to these European sites. The northern boundary of the site is adjacent to where the Clonakilty stream (waterbody code: IE_SW_20C050300, segment code: 20_2260) enters Clonakilty Bay. The eastern boundary of the site is directly adjacent to both Clonakilty Bay SAC (site code: 000091) and the Clonkilty Bay SPA (site code: 004081).
