Dear Inspector,

Re: Ringsend Waste Water Discharge Authorisation Application D0034

Further to Regulation 14(5) notice dated 10 November 2021, and 3rd June 2022 requesting IW to submit a license review application by 10/05/2022.

The Agency has requested Irish Water to submit a completed application form and the relevant supporting documentation including the appropriate fee.

The licence review application is for the proposed upgrade to the Ringsend wastewater treatment plant and the operational discharges from the collection network.

The proposed upgrade to the wastewater treatment plant is due to be delivered by 2025. The survey & assessment of the collection network is due to be completed by 2024.

Irish Water is currently preparing the relevant technical supporting reports to accompany the licence review application.

Irish Water proposes to submit the completed application and supporting technical documentation by end of Q1 2023
