Notice in accordance with Regulation 7 of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013 as amended, in respect of a licence review from Mr Michael Monagle for an installation located at Annakisha North, Doneraile, County Cork

Dear Sir,

I refer to your application for a licence review received by the EPA on 16 May 2023.

I advise that in accordance with Regulation 7 of the EPA (IE) (Licensing) Regulations 2013 as amended, the information required under the regulations in support of the application must be updated to reflect compliance with Regulation 7(b) as follows:

1. The newspaper and site notices published are not in compliance with the [Environmental Protection Agency \(Industrial Emissions\)\(Licensing\)\(Amendment\) Regulations 2020](#)

The EPA therefore requires you to *republish the newspaper and site notices* referring to the '[Newspaper Notice - Guidance for Applicants](#)' and '[Site Notice – Guidance for Applicants](#)' documents on the EPA website.

- Include reference to the First Schedule to the EPA Act of 1992 with regard to class of activity in both Site Notice and Newspaper Notice.
- Include heading in the Newspaper Notice as per the above guidance.

Please submit the following evidence that you have complied with the regulations:

1. An extract of the revised notice published in the newspaper, in PDF format;
2. An extract of the revised site notice erected on site;
3. Photographic evidence of the revised site notice erected on site.

The requested information should be submitted to the EPA within 28 Calendar Days of the date of this notice in order to allow the EPA to process and determine your application.

It should be noted that the eight-week period within which the EPA is to decide the proposed determination will commence on the day on which this notice has been complied with.
