Thank you for meeting with us on Monday in relation to the Murphy Concrete facility in Gormanston, Co Meath.

We are preparing the Technical Amendment application for a 'clerical amendment', i.e. a tonnage increase for inert material accepted at the site, as per our discussions.

Our ecologist have advised us that an AA Screening cannot be carried out for something that has already happened, i.e. the material above the – currently licensed volume – has already been used for the Site restoration. We were advised that an Ecological Impact Assessment would be better suited for this scenario.
