**Notice under Regulation 37(2) of
the EPA (Industrial Emissions)
(Licensing) Regulations, 2013.**

The EPA granted a revised licence, subject to conditions, on 5 July 2023, to Mr. Eoin O'Brien, Ballintubbrid East, Carrigwohill, County Cork, Reg. No. P0790-03, for Class 6.2 - The rearing of pigs in an installation where the capacity exceeds - (a) 750 places for sows, or (b) 2,000 places for production pigs which are each over 30kg at Mogeely Pig Farm, Annistown, Killeagh, County Cork. A person shall not question the validity of the decision of the Agency other than by way of an application for Judicial Review and any such application or any other legal proceedings must, in accordance with Section 87(10) of the EPA Act 1992 as amended, be instituted within the period of eight weeks beginning on the date of the giving of the decision. The decision, including the reasons and considerations on which the decision is based, the revised licence, conditions, and any subsequent updates may be viewed on www.epa.ie or at EPA Headquarters, P.O.
