Re: Notice in accordance with Regulation 18(3)(b) of the European Union (Waste Water Discharge) Regulations 2007 to 2020

Dear Sir or Madam

We refer to your application for a waste water discharge licence relating to agglomeration named Ringsend, Reg. No. D0034-02.

Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with Regulation 16 of the European Union (Waste Water Discharge) Regulations 2007 to 2020.

You are therefore required, in accordance with Regulation 18(3)(b) of the Regulations, to take steps to supply the information detailed below:

REGULATION 16 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

The Non-Technical Summary states there are 385 overflows associated with the Greater Dublin Area agglomeration. *Attachment C.1 – Discharges & Monitoring* lists 383 overflows.

1. Confirm whether the number of overflows listed in *Attachment C.1 – Discharges & Monitoring* or the Non-Technical Summary is correct. Provide an updated *Attachment C.1 – Discharges & Monitoring* or Non-Technical Summary, as required, to reflect the correct number of overflows.
2. State a reason for the difference in the grid coordinates and naming convention for overflows in the existing licence (D0034-01) vs. the data provided in *Attachment C.1*.
3. Update *Attachment C.1* to provide grid coordinates, *Name of Receiving Water* and *WFD Code Receiving Water* for all storm water overflow emission points.

Your reply to this notice should include a revised non-technical summary which reflects the information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information



impinges on the non-technical summary.

In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.

Please supply the information by 23 August 2023. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.
