

LEGAL NOTICES**APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE REVIEW OF A LICENCE**

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the E.P.A Act 1992, as amended, that Indaver Ireland

Limited, of 1st Floor, The Highline, Bakers Point, Pottery Road, Dun Laoghaire, County Dublin

intends to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency (E.P.A) for the review of the industrial

emissions licence (W0167-03) for the installation at Carranstown, Duleek, County Meath (National Grid Reference: 306326E, 270870N).

The class of activities at the site, in accordance with the First Schedule of the EPA Act of 1992 are as follows:

11.3 Disposal or recovery of waste in waste incineration plants or in waste co-incineration plants -

(a) for non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 3 tonnes per hour, and

(b) for hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 10 tonnes per day.

5.13(a) The production of inorganic chemicals, such as gases, such as ammonia, chlorine or hydrogen chloride, fluorine, or hydrogen fluoride, carbon oxides, sulphur compounds, nitrogen oxides, hydrogen, sulphur dioxide, carbonyl chloride

(production means the production on an industrial scale by chemical or biological processing).

11.6 Temporary storage of hazardous waste, (other than waste referred to in paragraph

11.5) pending any of the activities referred to in paragraph 11.2, 11.3, 11.5 or

11.7 with a total capacity exceeding 50 tonnes, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the site where the waste is generated.

An Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) relating to these activities, which has been

submitted to An Bord Pleanála, will be submitted to the Agency as part of this application. The environmental impact assessment report submitted to the Agency in accordance with section

83(2A)(d) of the Act of 1992, any information provided to the Agency under paragraph (e) or (f)(ii)(I) of section 83(2A) of the Act of 1992, any opinion issued by the Agency under section

83(2A)(de) of the Act of 1992 on the scope of the environmental impact assessment report, and any

further information, including reports and advice, relating to the environmental impact assessment as

may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the application, shall

each be made available on the Agency's website and at the headquarters of the Agency.

Submissions may be made in writing to the Agency in relation to the likely effects on the environment

of the proposed activity within the period specified by the Agency on its website under Regulation

4(2)(c). In accordance with section 87(2) of the Act of 1992 a proposed determination shall be

published by the Agency on its website.

A copy of the application for the licence may be inspected on the Agency's website or inspected at or

obtained from the headquarters of the Agency as soon as is practicable after the receipt by the Agency

of the application for the licence.
