

Notice for Public Consultation on Appropriate Assessment under Regulation 42 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 as amended

The EPA has given notice of its Appropriate Assessment Screening Determination to Galway County Council for a closed landfill located at Tuam Historic Landfill, Rinkippeen, Tuam, County Galway, in the townland of Rinkippeen, regarding an application for a certificate of authorisation, Register Number H0192-01. The application is for a certificate

Register Number H0192-01. The application is for a certificate of authorisation, including remedial measures required, at the above referenced closed landfill. The closed landfill site covers an area of approximately 3.4 hectares. Disposal of waste at the site was carried out from 1950s to 1998. Approximately 232,652 tonnes of waste was deposited at the site. The waste comprises of municipal waste, domestic waste, commercial and industrial (C&I) waste and construction & demolition (C&D) waste. The EPA has carried out an

The EPA has carried out an Appropriate Assessment Screening and has determined that an Appropriate Assessment <u>is required</u> for the activity.
