the EPA (industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations, 2013. The EPA granted a licence, subject to conditions, on 23/08/23, to M.A.G. World Limited, Drumeague, Bailieborough, Co Cavan, Reg. No. P1148-01, for Class 6.1 (a): the rearing of poultry in installations where the capacity exceeds 40,000 places at Lisgar and Corglass, Bailieboro, County Cavan. A person shall not question the validity of the decision of the Agency other than by way of an application for Judicial Review and any such application or any other legal proceedings must, in accordance with Section 87(10) of the EPA Act 1992 as amended, be instituted within the period of eight weeks beginning on the date of the giving of the decision.
