SEHL is part of the Beauparc Group, which operates a dedicated Safety, Health, Environment & Quality (SHEQ) Department whose members provide environmental operational and compliance support to all of the Group companies. An organogram of the SHEQ Department is attached.

The installation is subject to regulation by the OEE and is one of 15 SEHL licensed installations, of which 13 are operational and all of which have the appropriate financial provisions is place.

The SEHL Facility Manager, who has the appropriate training and experience as required by the Licence, is responsible for day-to-day facility operations, with designated responsibilities for performance and compliance support assigned to an appropriately qualified and experienced Environmental Officer. Appropriately trained and experienced staff are present all times when the facility is open to supervise waste acceptance, processing and transfer.

As roles change over time and some staff members leave organisations as part of their career progression typically individual names are not provided in licence applications. In addition there are implications for the applicant in relation to the provision of personal information on its employees under the General Data Protection Regulations.

SEHL has a NSAI accredited Integrated Management System (IMS) incorporating Environmental (ISO 14001:2015), Health & Safety (OHSAS 18001) and Quality (ISO9001:2007). These management systems are audited annually.

The key elements of the IMS comprise identifying environmental aspects associated with site activities; the determination of suitable operational controls (engineering and administrative); the identification of pertinent legal requirements; definition and implementation of objectives and targets; ongoing monitoring of performance and compliance; emergency planning, and regular management review of performance.
