





PUBLIC NOTICE APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE REVIEW OF A WASTE WATER DISCHARGE LICENCE

Éireann Irish Water

Pursuant to Regulation 9 of the European Union (Waste Water Discharge) Regulations 2007 to 2020, Uisce Éireann, Colvill House, 24-26 Talbot Street, Dublin 1, intend to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency for the review of the Waste Water Discharge Licence (D0034-01) for the Greater Dublin Area Agglomeration, Co. Dublin.


The waste water works serving the agglomeration located in post codes Dublin 1 to Dublin 24 inclusive, as well as additional areas in County Dublin, County Kildare and County Meath consists of an upgraded Waste Water Treatment Plant; an existing Primary Discharge (SW001); 51 no. Dual Function Overflows (i.e., act as a Storm Water Overflow or Emergency Overflow depending on the event); 339 no. network Storm Water Overflows, 2 no. Emergency Overflows, associated sewer network and pumping stations. Details of the location of these works and associated discharges are as follows:-
