Conditions

- 9.3.1 Amend the wording on condition 9.3.1 (vi) as follows: 'notify the Agency as required by Condition 11.4 11.5 of this licence'.
- 11.2 Insert a new condition 11.2 to read 'The licensee shall submit the reports, proposals and submissions required by this licence by the deadlines specified. The licensee shall not be in compliance with the requirements of this condition unless and until it has submitted every report, proposal and submission, the deadline for which has passed.'
- 11.2 Amend the numbering for this condition to *11.3*.

All subsequent conditions in the Recommended Determination should reflect the reordered numbering.

11.6 Following the renumbering outlined above, this condition will now read as condition number 11.7. Amend the wording as follows: 'The licensee shall make a record of any notification made under Condition 11.4 11.5 above. This record shall include details of the nature, extent, and impact of, and circumstances giving rise to, the incident or accident. The record shall include all corrective actions taken to manage the incident or accident, minimise wastes generated and the effect on the environment, and avoid recurrence. In the case of a breach of a condition, the record shall include measures to restore compliance.'
