Dear EPA,

Further to your letter of the 25<sup>th</sup> August in relation to our application for a certification of authorisation for St Mary's landfill in Limerick, we can confirm that this was an illegal landfill and the application was submitted in error.

Limerick City and County Council has carried out 3 separate Tiers of risk assessment at this site in line with the EPA code of practice for Environmental Risk Assessment of Unregulated Waste Disposal Sites. A Detailed Quantitative Risk Analysis (DQRA) was also carried out as part of the risk assessment. Remediation works were undertaken in 2015 as part of the greater regeneration aspect of the area and all waste has been removed from the site.
