



Re: Industrial Emissions licence review application for an increase in annual total waste for treatment from currently permitted 235,000 tonnes to 250,000 tonnes, increase in annual amount of hazardous waste from currently permitted 10,000 tonnes to 25,000 tonnes. development of an aqueous waste tank farm, hydrogen generation unit, bottom ash storage building, development of a single storage warehouse, new concrete yard, weather canopy, demolition and rebuilding of an existing single storey modular office and ancillary site works.

I have been asked by An Bord Pleanála to refer to your letters dated 21st July 2023 and 18th September 2023 in relation to the above-mentioned application for a review of an Industrial Emissions Licence under section 87(1B)(a)(i) of the EPA Act, 1992, as amended. In respect of the Environmental Protection Agency's request for observations in accordance with the provisions of section 87(1D)(a) of the EPA Act, 1992, as amended, and having regard to the specific queries raised in your letter, the Board would wish to comment as follows:

Having carried out an initial inspection of documents on the Agency's website, the Board considers that the activity, subject of the current Industrial Emissions licence review application, would appear to be the same as the proposed development which the Board approved, subject to conditions, as strategic infrastructure development, on 30th March 2022 under Board reference ABP-307433-20.

- The decision was made by the Board after the carrying out of an environmental impact
  assessment and following a request for further information and receipt of the report of an
  engineering consultant and the report of an Inspector on the said case, which includes a
  section on environmental impact assessment and consideration of key associated issues.
- The Agency's attention is brought to the issues set out in the Inspector's report and assessment and the Board's final decision, as set out in the Direction and Order, with particular attention to the Reasons and Considerations and Conditions imposed on the grant of permission.
