Regulation 10(2)(b)(ii) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, in respect of a licence review from Starrus Eco Holdings Limited for an installation located at Millennium Business Park, Grange, Ballycoolin, Dublin 11.

Dear Sir or Madam,

I refer to the application for a licence received by the EPA on 25 August 2023.

Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with the above-mentioned legislation. You are therefore requested, in accordance with the regulations, to supply the information detailed below.

Regulation 8 of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013 requires a notice to be provided to the relevant planning authority regarding an application made to the Agency for a licence. You are therefore requested, to re-submit the letter to the relevant planning authority regarding an application made to the Agency. Please refer to 'Newspaper Notice - Guidance for Applicants' with regard to the information to be contained in the letter to the relevant planning authority, including details of the EIAR submitted.

Regulation 9(4)(e) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013 requires the appropriate fee as per the schedule of fees to be submitted with the application. It is noted that the sum of €6,000 has been received. The application submitted relates to the below listed activities:

As the application indicates an increase in waste tonnage to 450,000 tonnes/year, the appropriate fee to be submitted for the above listed activities is €21,000, based on Schedule Part 1 of [SI 284 of 2013](#) as per the extract below.

The balance of €15,000 should be submitted to the Agency by cheque or Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT). ***Please arrange for the outstanding balance to be paid and provide evidence of payment in response to this letter.***

The requested information should be submitted to the Agency within *4 weeks from date of this notice*, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application.
