Notice is hereby given in accordance with regulation 5 the Environmental Protection Agency (E.P.A) regulations 2013 S.I 137 of 2013 amended by EPA regulations 2020 S.I. 190 of 2020 that, Carhue Piggeries Limited of Cooligboy, Timoleague, Bandon, Co Cork intends to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency for a review of licence for the rearing of pigs on site at Cooligboy, Timoleague, Bandon, Co Cork. National Grid Reference: E145647 N043954.

The Activity carried out in accordance with the first schedule to the Act 1992 is 06 Intensive Agriculture Class 6.2 (a) The Rearing of pigs in an installation where the capacity exceeds 750 places for sows
Class 6.2 (b) The rearing of pigs in an installation where the capacity exceeds 2000 places for production pigs which are over 30kg

An Environmental Impact Statement (E.I.S) relating to this activity, which has previously been submitted to Cork County Council, will be submitted to the Agency as part of this application along with an updated AA Screening and Natura Impact Statement (NIS)

The Environmental Impact statement submitted to the Agency in accordance with section 83(2A)(d) of the Act of 1992, any information provided to the Agency under paragraph (e) or (f)(ii)(II) of section 83(2A) of the Act of 1992, any opinion issued by the Agency under section 83(2A)(de) of the act of 1992 on the scope of the environmental impact Assessment report and any further information, including reports and advice, relating to the environmental impact statement as may be furnished to the agency in the course of the agency's consideration of the application shall each be made available on the Agency's website and at the headquarters of the Agency. Submissions may be made in writing to the Agency in relation to the likely effects on the environment of the proposed activity within the period specified by the Agency on its website under Regulation 4(2) (c) and in accordance with section 87(2) of the Act of 1992, a proposed determination shall be published by the Agency on its website.

A copy of the application for the Licence Review may be inspected on the Agency's website or inspected or obtained from the headquarters of the Agency as soon as is practicable after receipt by the Agency
