Notice is hereby given in accordance with the E.P.A. Acts 1992 as amended, that Carhue Piggeries Ltd, Cooligboy, Timoleague, Bandon, Co Cork intends to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency (E.P.A.) for a review of the Industrial Emissions licence for the rearing of Pigs at Cooligboy, Timoleague, Bandon, Co Cork. National Grid Reference E145647 N043954

This Activity is classed as 06 Intensive Agriculture under the First Schedule of the EPA Act of 1992

**Class 6.2 (a)**                    The rearing of pigs in an installation where capacity exceeds 750 places for sows

**Class 6.2 (b)**                    The rearing of pigs in an installation where the capacity exceeds 2000 places for production pigs which are over 30kg

An Environmental Impact Statement (E.I.S) relating to this activity, which has previously been submitted to Cork County Council, will be submitted to the Agency as part of this application along with an updated AA Screening Natura Impact Statement (NIS).

The Environmental Impact statement submitted to the Agency in accordance with section 83(2A)(d) of the Act of 1992, any information provided to the Agency under paragraph (e) or (f)(ii)(II) of section 83(2A) of the Act of 1992 and any opinion issued by the Agency under section 83(2A)(de) of the act of 1992 on the scope of the environmental impact statement and any further information, including reports and advice, relating to the environmental impact statement as may be furnished to the agency in the course of the agency’s consideration of the application shall each be made available on the Agency’s website and at the headquarters of the Agency.

Submissions may be made in writing to the Agency in relation to the likely effects on the environment of the proposed activities within the period specified by the Agency on its website under Regulation 4(2) (c) and in accordance with section 87(2) of the Act of 1992, the proposed determination shall be published by the Agency on its website.

A copy of the application for the Licence Review may be inspected on the Agency’s website or inspected or obtained from the headquarters of the Agency as soon as is practicable after receipt by the Agency
