Notice under Regulation 20 of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations, 2013.

Starrus Eco Holdings Limited, Panda Waste Management Solutions, Ballymount Road Upper, Dublin 24, Dublin located at Cappagh Road, Finglas, Dublin 11, Reg. No. W0261-03, applied to the Agency for a review of the existing licence, Reg. No. W0261-02. On the 21 December 2023 the Agency proposed to grant a revised licence, subject to conditions, for Class: -11.4 (b)(ii).
