PUBLIC NOTICE

APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE REVIEW OF A WASTE WATER DISCHARGE LICENCE

Pursuant to Regulation 9 of the European Union (Waste Water Discharge) Regulations 2007 to 2020, Uisce Éireann, Colvill House, 24-26 Talbot Street, Dublin 1, intend to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency for the review of the Waste Water Discharge Licence (D0427-01) for the Coachford Waste Water Treatment Works, Co. Cork. The Waste Water Treatment Works consists of a new Waste Water Treatment Plant at Clontead Beg Townland (NGR 146003E, 073146N); a Primary Discharge (SW001) which discharges to the Inniscarra Reservoir; a Dual Function Overflow, SW006, (i.e., Overflow which can act as a Storm Water Overflow or Emergency Overflow depending on the event), 2 no. Storm Water Overflows (SW005 and SW007) and associated sewer network. Details of the location of these works and associated discharges are as follows:
