AA Screening Determination:

That the activity is not directly connected with or necessary to the management of any European site and that it can be excluded, on the basis of objective information, that the activity, individually or in combination with other plans or projects, will not have a significant effect on any European site and accordingly determined that an Appropriate Assessment of the activity was not required.

This determination has been made in light of the following reasons:

- The installation is not located within a European site.
- There are no process emissions to surface water or groundwater from the installation.
- The distance and lack of hydrological connectivity connecting the European sites and their qualifying interests listed in No. 2 to 12 above to the installation.
- The activity will not have a likely significant effect on the South Dublin Bay & Tolka River Estuary SPA in light of the scale and nature of the storm water discharges to the environment and the distance from the installation to the European site and its qualifying interests.
- The European sites and their qualifying interests are determined to be outside the zone of influence of fugitive dust, odour and noise emissions due to the distance from the installation.
